Tinsley Griffin Hill is an associate in HunterMaclean's Litigation practice group.

She previously served as an attorney with the Alabama Law Institute, working with the state's Legislative Services Agency on policy and legislative matters involving family law, election procedures, probate law, and healthcare reform. Earlier in her career, she maintained a solo practice handling cases related to domestic relations, landlord-tenant issues, and confidentiality protections.

Tinsley earned both her J.D. and Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Alabama, becoming the first woman to complete the school's joint degree program. During law school, she was President of the Christian Legal Society, served on the Managing Board of the *Journal of the Legal Profession*, and was active in moot court and service organizations. She was awarded the Order of the Samaritan, given to Alabama Law students who demonstrate excellence in service to the community. Her doctoral research focused on prosecutorial discretion in felony plea bargaining, and she also taught undergraduate courses in American politics while completing her graduate studies.

She holds a B.S. in Political Science from the University of Mobile, where she graduated summa cum laude and received the Weaver Award as the highest-ranking female graduate.

Tinsley currently resides in her native Savannah with her husband, Joshua, and her daughter, Luthien. In her free time, she enjoys playing the violin and playing with her dogs, Merlin and Minerva.
